ADOREMUS CELEBRATIONS

St Cuthbert's will have their **Parish Solemn Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament** on Friday 28th September (from after the 10.00am Mass to 8.00pm); on Saturday 29th September (from after the 10.00am Mass to 5.00pm) and on Sunday 30th September (from 1.00pm to 2.00pm). This is the first such celebration there for some years. Do please visit St Cuthbert's or speak to one of the priests about taking a slot to keep watch for half an hour!

We had our hugely successful St John Vianney & St Monica's Corpus Christi Procession on 3 June and our Solemn Exposition before that in February - but St Cuthbert's Parish Solemn Exposition will culminate in a special **Deanery Corpus Christi Procession & Benediction** at 2.00pm on Sunday 30th September at St Cuthbert's - all are most welcome!
